



Goodwill® Announces Opening of New Store in Salem

Roanoke, VA. Goodwill Industries® of the Valleys is excited to announce the grand opening of its newest retail store on West Main Street in Salem. The grand opening is scheduled for Thursday, January 6th with a “Tie” cutting ceremony at 8:45am. During the ceremony local officials, community leaders, and Goodwill representatives will welcome the new store to the community. The doors will open for shoppers at approximately 9am.

During the grand opening festivities, which will continue through Sunday, January 9th, shoppers will have the opportunity to register to win a new flat screen television and take advantage of thousands of bargains throughout the store. The new Salem store, located at 1830 West Main Street (the former Dave Sarmadi Mitsubishi location) will be open Monday – Saturday from 8am – 9pm and Sunday Noon – 6pm. The new store will offer the community over 7,000 square feet of retail space to shop for high quality, low cost furniture, books, household items, and clothing for the entire family, as well as a convenient drive-thru donation center.

“Goodwill is excited to expand to better serve the Salem community,” states Bruce Phipps, President & CEO. “In 2010 Goodwill will assist over 40,000 individuals, and in this difficult employment market will place more than 1,400 people into jobs in our community. When the community donates and shops at Goodwill, they are helping people achieve the pride, dignity, and self respect that come from real work.”

Goodwill retail stores support the training and employment programs for individuals who face barriers to employment. Last year the donated goods operation generated \$24.1 million in revenue and provided over 578 jobs in the communities served by Goodwill in Virginia. The new store, Goodwill’s 32nd store location, will employ 17 people, including supervisory positions.

The new Salem location’s proximity to local businesses and residential neighborhoods will make it convenient to shop and donate. Goodwill accepts gently used clothing, household items, furniture, small appliances, and computers of any brand and condition. Donation Center hours are Monday – Saturday from 8am – 9pm and Sunday noon – 6pm.
